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**BID AWARD SUMMARY FOR  
Emergency Watershed (PLAN-EA) PL-556  
Contract to create an emergency watershed plan for the  
Skull Valley Goshute Indian Reservation**

In December of 2018 Tooele County Commissioners committed Tooele County Emergency Management to work with the USDA- Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) to act as the sponsoring agent for an emergency watershed plan to be created for the Skull Valley (Goshute) Indian Reservation. As a sponsoring agent Tooele County agrees to work as the intermediary to find engineering firms to conduct the study. The funding to pay for the development of this plan is coming from a federal grant of \$270,000.00. **Tooele County is not funding any portions of this project we are only functioning as the sponsoring agent to coordinate the project.**

Since that time Emergency Management has solicited bids for the project.

- The bids have been reviewed by a committee of 5 members made up of representatives from Tooele County, NRCS and the Goshute Reservation.
- The bid committee evaluated bids on their technical merits and overall cost.
- Each firm who submitted a proposal received points on a 0-100 scale for the technical aspects
- Each firms cost proposal was graded on a scale of 0-10 points .
- Scores for each aspect of the proposal were combined for an overall score.
- The firm with the highest overall score received the award for the project,

**The firm that has been selected is Bowen Collins & Associates, \$269,655.00**

**Bowens Collins and Associates received the highest combined point award of those firms who submitted a proposal for the project.**

- Firms must be complete with the study by **January 1<sup>st</sup> of 2022.**
