

GRANTSVILLE CITY VOTING INFORMATION

Our municipality is conducting a mail election. Follow the steps below to vote:

1. If you are an active registered voter, your ballot will be mailed to you between October 15, 2019 and October 22, 2019. If you do not receive your ballot. Immediately contact the Tooele County Clerk's Office at (435) 843-3140.
2. Follow the instructions provided with the ballot.
3. Make sure your ballot is counted by either:
 - Postmarking your ballot on or before November 4, 2019 (the day before the election).
 - Dropping your ballot off at a polling location or a drop box by 8:00 pm on Election Day. There is a drop box in the parking lot at Grantsville City Hall next to the utility payment drop box.



To ensure you receive a ballot, make sure you are registered and your mailing address is up to date. Please visit vote.utah.gov to determine if you are registered, or to check that your voter registration is current.

Every registered voter will receive a ballot in the mail. You may go to the Grantsville Fire Station on Election Day from 7:00 am to 8:00 pm to turn in your ballot. If there are problems with your ballot, or if you do not receive one, you can go to the Grantsville Fire Station. After you straighten out whatever the problem may be, you will be given a paper ballot, just like the one you received in the mail. If you have to change your information (moved and didn't re-register) you will also have to fill out a provisional form. **Identification is required to vote at the poll. For a list of valid forms of identification, please go to vote.utah.gov or contact the City Recorder's Office.**

Voters will have the responsibility to vote on a referendum petition question entitled Proposition #8, which asks whether or not to repeal Ordinance 2017-17.

THE OFFICIAL TEXT OF THE GRANTSVILLE CITY PROPOSITION #8 IS AS FOLLOWS:

The Grantsville City Council passed Ordinance 2017-07 amending the official zoning map of Grantsville City at 300 South SR-112. Ordinance 2017-07 rezones 5.05 acres of land from a CS zone to a RM-15 zone. The CS (Commercial Shopping District) zone permits shopping center development at a community level scale. The RM-15 (Multiple Residential District) permits medium or high density residential units with the opportunity for varied housing styles and character. No other property is affected by Ordinance 2017-07.
