

**ORDINANCE 2000-3**

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A TEMPORARY ZONING REGULATION REGARDING BILLBOARDS FOR TOOELE COUNTY**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Utah Code Annotated 17-27-404(1)(a) a county legislative body may enact an ordinance establishing a temporary zoning regulation for any part or all of the area within the county; and

**WHEREAS**, this ordinance is for the purpose of establishing a temporary zoning regulations regarding billboards for Tooele County.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE TOOELE COUNTY COMMISSION, WHICH IS THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF TOOELE COUNTY, ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION I.** There is hereby established a temporary zoning regulation regarding billboards. Applications currently pending for the erection of billboards and applications yet to be filed for erection of billboards along all highways within Tooele County are hereby placed in a state of moratorium for a period not to exceed six (6) months. During such period of time Tooele County will refine its sign ordinance, a process which is already underway, which ordinance affects billboards, with the intent of creating a permanent ordinance that will properly regulate the time, place and/or manner for the erection of same. This moratorium does not apply to applications merely to upgrade existing billboards, so long as their size and height are not increased.

**SECTION II - REPEALER.** Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**SECTION III - EFFECTIVE DATE.** It is the opinion of the Tooele County Commission that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health or safety of the




County and the inhabitants thereof. It shall, therefore, take effect immediately upon publication in one issue of a newspaper published in and having general circulation in Tooele County.


