

**ORDINANCE 2000-12**

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 2000-3 WHICH HAD ESTABLISHED A TEMPORARY ZONING REGULATION REGARDING BILLBOARDS**

**THE COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY OF THE COUNTY OF TOOELE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION I - REPEALER:** Ordinance 2000-3, which established a temporary zoning regulation regarding billboards is hereby repealed because the county adopted Ordinance 2000-8 amending Chapter 24, Sign Regulations.




