

**ORDINANCE 2000-18**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE UNIFORM ZONING ORDINANCE OF TOOELE COUNTY, CHAPTER 24, SIGN ORDINANCE, REGARDING BILLBOARDS**

**THE COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY OF THE COUNTY OF TOOELE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION I - SECTION AMENDED.** Subsection 24-8(9) of the Uniform Zoning Ordinance of Tooele County is hereby amended to read as follows:

- (9) Off-premises billboard signs are allowed only along Interstate 80 and shall:
- (a) be oriented for viewing from Interstate 80;
  - (b) be located within 100 feet of the nearest freeway lane and within one and one half miles of an existing freeway exit;
  - (c) be allowed only in M-D or M-G industrial or C-G or C-H commercial zoning districts;
  - (d) have a maximum area of 675 square feet for one side of a sign, whether single or double faced;
  - (e) be a maximum of 25 feet above the grade of the traveled way or ground level, whichever is higher;
  - (f) not be erected within 500 feet of another existing billboard sign;
  - (g) not be erected within 1,500 feet of any residential zoning district boundary; and
  - (h) be of a monopole construction.

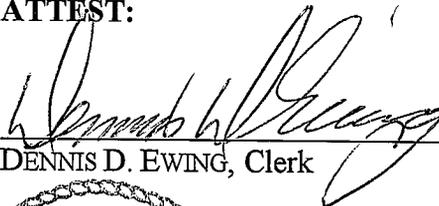
**SECTION II - REPEALER.** Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**SECTION III - EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its passage, provided the same has been published, with the name of the members voting for and against the same, for at least one publication in one issue of a newspaper published in and having general circulation in Tooele County.

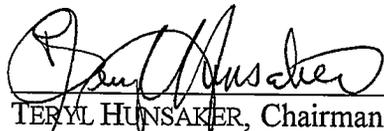

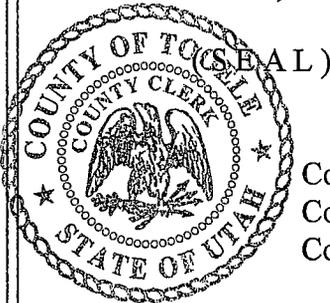

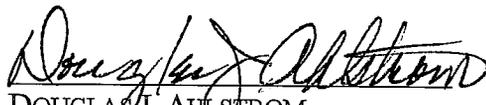
