

ORDINANCE 2000-20

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A TEMPORARY ZONING REGULATION IMPOSING A MORATORIUM ON THE CREATION OF NEW SAND AND GRAVEL PITS

WHEREAS, pursuant to Utah Code Annotated 17-27-404(1)(a) a county legislative body may enact an ordinance establishing a temporary zoning regulation for any part or all of the area within the county; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance is for the purpose of establishing a temporary zoning regulation imposing a moratorium on the creation of new sand and gravel pits in Tooele County.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE TOOELE COUNTY COMMISSION, WHICH IS THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF TOOELE COUNTY, ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. There is hereby established a temporary zoning regulation imposing a moratorium on the creation of new sand and gravel pits. Applications yet to be filed for sand and gravel pits within Tooele County are hereby placed in a state of moratorium for a period not to exceed six (6) months. During such period of time Tooele County will refine its ordinance for the location and number of sand and gravel mining operations, with the intent of creating a permanent ordinance that will properly regulate them.

SECTION II - REPEALER. Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.



It is the opinion of the Tooele County Commission that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health or safety of the County and the inhabitants thereof. It shall, therefore, take effect immediately upon publication in one issue of a newspaper published in and having general circulation in Tooele County.



