AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A TEMPORARY BAN ON THE DISCHARGE OF FIREWORKS IN TOOELE COUNTY

WHEREAS, this ordinance is for the purpose of establishing a temporary ban on fireworks within Tooele County because of extreme fire danger;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE TOOELE COUNTY COMMISSION, WHICH IS THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF TOOELE COUNTY, ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. Due to dry conditions and extreme fire danger, there is hereby established a ban on the discharge of fireworks in the county through October 31, 2000. A person is guilty of a class C misdemeanor if he violates this provision.

SECTION II - REPEALER. Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION III - EFFECTIVE DATE. It is the opinion of the Tooele County Commission that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health or safety of the County and the inhabitants thereof. It shall, therefore, take effect immediately upon publication in one issue of a newspaper published in and having general circulation in Tooele County.
