

ORDINANCE 2001-8

**AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF A
COUNTY ROAD AT ARAGONITE**

**THE COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY OF THE COUNTY OF TOOELE ORDAINS
AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION I - PURPOSE. It is the purpose of this ordinance to vacate a portion of a county road at Aragonite in Section 8, Township 1 South, Range 10 West, SLB&M as it crosses the Union Pacific Railroad tracks.

SECTION II - FINDINGS OF FACT. The unnamed road in question crosses the Union Pacific Railroad at a location where a rail siding is to be installed. Rather than create a double crossing it is recommended that this crossing be vacated as the public can use a signaled crossing two miles away and still access the same properties. Proper notice of a public hearing was given pursuant to Utah Code Annotated 72-3-108. The planning commission has considered the vacation and recommends it be made. This ordinance is adopted pursuant to Utah Code Annotated 72-3-108. There is good cause to vacate this portion of the county road and the vacation will not be detrimental to the general interest, there being an alternative railroad crossing nearby.

SECTION III - VACATION OF COUNTY ROAD. A portion of a county road at Aragonite in Tooele County, Utah, is hereby formally vacated pursuant to Section 72-3-108, U.C.A. 1953, as amended. The road described as:

That portion of the road as it crosses the Union Pacific Railroad line in Section 8, Township 1 South, Range 10 West, SLB&M.



For reference purposes, a map showing the location of the road vacation is attached hereto and made a part thereof. The right-of-way and easements, if any, of a property owner and the franchise rights of any public utility shall not be impaired by vacating this road.

SECTION III - EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective and in force fifteen (15) days after its passage, provided the same has been published prior thereto as provided by law. If this ordinance has not been published within fifteen (15) days after its passage, it shall take effect upon publication.


