

**ORDINANCE 2001-18**

**AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF A  
COUNTY ROAD SOUTHWEST OF GRANTSVILLE**

**THE COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY OF THE COUNTY OF TOOELE ORDAINS  
AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION I - PURPOSE.** It is the purpose of this ordinance to vacate a portion of a county road southwest of Grantsville in Sections 11 and 14, Township 4 South, Range 6 West, SLB&M.

**SECTION II - FINDINGS OF FACT.** The unnamed road in question crosses the properties of Ed Roberts and Charles A. Eliason. Mr. Roberts petitioned for the vacation, there being other easy access to surrounding properties. The planning commission has recommended that the north-south portion of the road only be vacated. Proper notice of a public hearing was given pursuant to Utah Code Annotated 72-3-108. The county commission finds there is good cause to vacate the north-south portion of the county road and the vacation will not be detrimental to the general interest.

**SECTION III - VACATION OF COUNTY ROAD.** The north-south portion of a county road that is 66 feet wide and follows the quarter section line of Sections 11 and 14, Township 4 South, Range 6 West, Salt Lake Base and Meridian in Tooele County, Utah, is hereby formally vacated pursuant to Section 72-3-108, U.C.A. 1953, as amended. The county road vacated hereby is described as follows:

Thirty-three feet on both sides of the road's centerline which commences at the northeast corner of the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter of Section 11, Township 4 South, Range 6 West, Salt Lake Base and Meridian; and runs thence southerly along the quarter section line to the northeast corner of the northwest quarter of Section 14; thence southerly along the quarter section line to the southwest corner of the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter of said Section 14.

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
For reference purposes, a map showing the location of the road vacation is attached hereto and made a part thereof. The right-of-way and easements, if any, of a property owner and the franchise rights of any public utility shall not be impaired by vacating this county road.

**SECTION III - EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall become effective and in force fifteen (15) days after its passage, provided the same has been published prior thereto as provided by law. If this ordinance has not been published within fifteen (15) days after its passage, it shall take effect upon publication.




