**AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF A
COUNTY ROAD SOUTHWEST OF TOOELE CITY**

**THE COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY OF THE COUNTY OF TOOELE ORDAINS
AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION I - PURPOSE. It is the purpose of this ordinance to vacate a portion of a county road southwest of Tooele City in Sections 30 and 31, Township 3 South, Range 4 West, SLB&M.

SECTION II - FINDINGS OF FACT. The unnamed road in question crosses the property of Fred Swedin. Mr. Swedin petitioned for the vacation. There is other easy access to surrounding properties. The planning commission recommends the road be vacated. Proper notice of a public hearing was given pursuant to Utah Code Annotated 72-3-108. The county commission finds there is good cause to vacate this road and the vacation will not be detrimental to the general interest.

SECTION III - VACATION OF COUNTY ROAD. The unnamed county road in Sections 30 and 31, Township 3 South, Range 4 West, Salt Lake Base and Meridian in Tooele County, Utah, is hereby formally vacated pursuant to Section 72-3-108, U.C.A. 1953, as amended. The county road vacated hereby is shown on the attached plat and is described as follows:

That part of the existing 66-foot wide county road more or less centered on the south section line of Section 30, Township 3 South, Range 4 West, SLB&M; beginning at a point on the West edge of Mr. Swedin's property conveyed in Bk 330, Pg 211-214, of official records in the Tooele County Recorder's Office, which is 590 feet more or less east of the S1/4 corner of said Section 30, and running thence East 850.4 feet.

The county recorder is directed to vest ownership of the vacated road in the property owners on either side of the road.

SECTION IV - EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective and in force fifteen (15) days after its passage, provided the same has been published prior thereto as provided


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by law. If this ordinance has not been published within fifteen (15) days after its passage, it shall take effect upon publication.


IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Legislative Body of Tooele County passed, approved and enacted this Ordinance this 5th day of June 2001.


