**AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF A
COUNTY ROAD NEAR IBAPAH ROAD**

THE COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY OF THE COUNTY OF TOOELE ORDAINS

AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I - PURPOSE. It is the purpose of this ordinance to vacate a portion of a county road in Ibapah called Felt Drive located in Section 21, Township 9 South, Range 19 West, SLB&M.

SECTION II - FINDINGS OF FACT. Felt Road approaches the Ibapah Road at an oblique angle. Approval of the Deep Creek PUD will reroute Felt Road to make a 90 degree angle intersection with Ibapah Road. The planning commission recommends the road be vacated. Proper notice of a public hearing was given pursuant to Utah Code Annotated 72-3-108. The county commission finds there is good cause to vacate this road and the vacation will not be detrimental to the general interest.

SECTION III - VACATION OF COUNTY ROAD. A portion of Felt Road in Ibapah in Section 21, Township 9 South, Range 19 West, Salt Lake Base and Meridian in Tooele County, Utah, is hereby formally vacated pursuant to Section 72-3-108, U.C.A. 1953, as amended. The county road vacated hereby is shown on the attached plat and is described as follows:

Beginning at a point that lies South 89°41'00" West 34.73 feet and South 0°19'00" East 313.68 feet from the northeast corner of Section 21, Township 9 South, Range 19 West, Salt Lake Base and Meridian, said point also being on the West right-of-way line of Ibapah Road; thence North 63°33'17" West 501.94 feet to the beginning of a curve to the left having a radius of 275 feet and a central angle of 26°26'43"; thence along said curve 126.928 feet; thence North 50 feet to the beginning of a curve to the right having a radius of 325' and a central angle of 26°26'43"; thence along said curve 150.006'; thence South 63°33'17" East 477.071 feet to a point on the West right-of-way line of Ibapah Road; thence along said right-of-way line South 55.844 feet to point of beginning.

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
The county recorder is directed to vest ownership of the vacated road in the property owners on either side of the road.

SECTION IV - EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective and in force only at such time as a dedication of the realigned road is made, and then only if fifteen (15) days have elapsed after this ordinance's passage, provided the same has been published prior thereto as provided by law.


IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Legislative Body of Tooele County passed, approved and enacted this Ordinance this 17th day of July 2001.


