

ORDINANCE 2001-39

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING FEES FOR MUNICIPAL SERVICES

THE COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY OF THE COUNTY OF TOOELE ORDAINS

AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: SECTION ENACTED. Section 1-6-2 is hereby enacted to read:

1-6-2. Fees for municipal services.

(1) In addition to other fees or charges imposed for municipal-type services it provides, the county shall charge fees for the following services and functions:

- (a) fire protection;
- (b) special event security;
- (c) hazardous materials or waste cleanup;
- (d) hazardous materials transportation escort; and
- (e) oversize or overweight transportation escort.


(2) The fees charged for the services in Subsection (1) shall be equal to \$40 per man-hour expended, plus actual costs of materials, supplies and equipment used in providing such services.

SECTION II - REPEALER. Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION III - EFFECTIVE DATE. It is the opinion of the Tooele County Commission that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health or safety of the County and the inhabitants thereof. It shall, therefore, take effect fifteen (15) days after passage.


