**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING NEW TOOELE COUNTY
ELECTION PRECINCTS AND REAPPORTIONING
TOOELE COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD DISTRICT
BOUNDARIES TO COINCIDE WITH THE NEW ELECTION
PRECINCTS**

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF TOOELE COUNTY ORDAINS

AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I - PURPOSE. As a result of newly established State Legislative Districts, Tooele County is required to amend its election precincts to coincide with the State districts. This ordinance is, therefore, for the purpose of amending and consolidating Tooele County election districts. This Ordinance is also for the purpose of reapportioning the Tooele County School Board Districts, pursuant to Section 20A-14-201 et seq. UCA, as amended. This State law requires a reapportionment of school district precincts every ten (10) years to achieve as nearly as possible equal population, compactness and contiguity.

SECTION II - REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES. All Tooele County ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with any provision of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION III - ESTABLISHMENT OF NEW TOOELE COUNTY ELECTION PRECINCTS. There are hereby established thirty-eight (38) new election precincts within Tooele County. Such precincts are described by the maps and census tracts and blocks designated as Exhibits A, B, and C which are attached hereto and by reference are made a part hereof. The abbreviated designations for each precinct on the attached maps shall be interpreted according to the following legend, which establishes the full name of each election precinct. T1 through T19

refers to Tooele precincts #1 through #19; G1 through G5 refers to Grantsville precincts #1 through #5; LP refers to Lake Point; SP1 through SP3 refers to Stansbury Park precincts #1 through #3; ER refers to Erda; LI refers to Lincoln; ST refers to Stockton; OP refers to Ophir; RV refers to Rush Valley; VE refers to Vernon; TE refers to Terra; DU refers to Dugway; IB refers to Irapah; and WE refers to Wendover.

The official census population figures maps of the Bureau of Census of the United States Department of Commerce developed in connection with the taking of the 2000 National Decennial Census and census tracts and blocks compiled by the Tooele County Clerk and used as the basis for the formulation of these new election precinct maps shall be retained by the county clerk and shall serve as the indication of legislative intent in drawing these election precinct boundaries.

SECTION IV – LOCAL SCHOOL BOARD DISTRICTS REAPPORTIONED. The Tooele County School Board districts are hereby reapportioned in conformity with the new election precincts established in Section III as follows:

1. **Tooele County School Board District Number 1** shall consist of and include the following Tooele County Election precincts: Tooele #1 (T1), Tooele #2 (T2), Tooele #3 (T#), Tooele #4 (T4), Tooele #5 (T5), Tooele #6 (T6), Tooele #7 (T7), and Tooele #8 (T8).
2. **Tooele County School Board District Number 2** shall consist of and include the following Tooele County election precincts: Tooele #13 (T13), Tooele #14 (T14), Tooele #15 (T15), Tooele #16 (T16), Tooele #17 (T17), Tooele #18 (T18), and Tooele #19 (T19).

3. **Tooele County School Board District Number 3** shall consist of and include the following Tooele County election precincts: Tooele #9 (T9), Tooele #10 (T10), Tooele #11 (T11), Tooele #12 (T12), Lincoln (LI), Stansbury Park #2 (SP2), and Stansbury Park #3 (SP3).


4. **Tooele County School Board District Number 4** shall consist of and include the following Tooele County election precincts: Grantsville #1 (G1), Grantsville #2 (G2), Grantsville #3 (G3), Grantsville #4 (G4), Grantsville #5 (G5), Erda (ER) and Stansbury Park #1 (SP1).

5. **Tooele County School Board District Number 5** shall consist of and include the following Tooele County election precincts: Stockton (ST), Ophir (OP), Rush Valley (RV), Vernon (VE), Terra (TE), Dugway (DU), Ibapah (IB), Wendover (WE), and Lake Point (LP).

SECTION V - EFFECTIVE DATE. In the opinion of the Board of County Commissioners of Tooele County, it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the county and the inhabitants thereof that this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon publication in one issue of a newspaper having general circulation within the county.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Board of County Commissioners of Tooele County has passed, approved, and enacted this ordinance this 15th day of January 2002.




