

**ORDINANCE 2002-21**

**AN ORDINANCE ENACTING TITLE 6-13-10 OF THE TOOELE COUNTY CODE, PROHIBITING PUBLIC GATHERINGS OF 100 PERSONS OR MORE IN ALL AREAS OF TOOELE COUNTY UNTIL JANUARY 1, 2003, EXCEPT IN THOSE AREAS WITH DEVELOPED WATER SOURCES CAPABLE OF SUSTAINING EFFECTIVE FIRE SUPPRESSION.**

**THE COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY OF THE COUNTY OF TOOELE  
ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION I - TITLE ENACTED.** Title 6-13-10 of the Tooele County Code is hereby amended to read as attached hereto.

Other provisions of the Tooele County Code notwithstanding, because of extreme fire danger, public gatherings of 100 persons or more are prohibited in all areas of Tooele County until January 1, 2003, except in those areas with developed water sources capable of sustaining effective fire suppression.

**SECTION II - REPEALER.** Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.


**SECTION III - EFFECTIVE DATE.** It is the opinion of the Tooele County Commission that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health or safety of the County and the inhabitants thereof. It shall, therefore, take effect immediately upon publication in one issue of a newspaper published in and having general circulation in Tooele County.


