

ORDINANCE 2002-22

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 24.7(m)(i) OF THE UNIFORM ZONING ORDINANCE OF TOOELE COUNTY, UTAH, CHANGING THE POSTING PERIOD OF POLITICAL CAMPAIGN SIGNS.

THE COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY OF THE COUNTY OF TOOELE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I - SECTION AMENDED. A public hearing having been held pursuant to statute, Section 24.7(m)(i) of the Uniform Zoning Ordinance of Tooele County, Utah, is hereby amended to read:

(i) Such signs may not be erected earlier than 60 days prior to a primary or general election and shall be removed no later than two weeks following the election. Candidates who lose an election shall remove signs by the Monday following the election. Signs relating to elections on special issues may be installed and must be removed on the same basis. However, written permission of the property owner must be obtained before they are erected.


SECTION II - REPEALER. Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION III - EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its passage, provided the same has been published, with the name of the members voting for and against the same, for at least one publication in one issue of a newspaper published in and having general circulation in Tooele County.


