

ORDINANCE 2002-25

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING TOOELE COUNTY CODE SECTION 6-13-10, WHICH PROHIBITED PUBLIC GATHERINGS OF 100 PERSONS OR MORE UNTIL JANUARY 1, 2003

THE COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY OF THE COUNTY OF TOOELE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION I - SECTION REPEALED. Section 6-13-10 of the Tooele County Code is hereby repealed.

SECTION II - REPEALER. Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.


SECTION III - EFFECTIVE DATE. It is the opinion of the Tooele County Commission that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health or safety of the County and the inhabitants thereof. It shall, therefore, take effect immediately upon publication in one issue of a newspaper published in and having general circulation in Tooele County.


IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the legislative body of Tooele County passed, approved and enacted this ordinance this 24th day of September 2002.
