

**ORDINANCE 2002-28**

**AN ORDINANCE ENACTING SECTION 25-8 OF THE UNIFORM ZONING ORDINANCE OF TOOELE COUNTY, ESTABLISHING DRINKING WATER SOURCE PROTECTION OVERLAY ZONING AROUND THE "HOLE IN THE ROCK" WELL**

**THE COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY OF THE COUNTY OF TOOELE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION I - SECTION ENACTED:** Section 25-8 of the Uniform Zoning Ordinance of Tooele County is enacted to read:


The Drinking Water Source Protection Overlay Zone is hereby applied to the "Hole in the Rock" well located in T2S, R4W, SLB&M. The zone shall have such boundaries as are shown on the following map, Figure 1.

**SECTION II - REPEALER.** Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**SECTION III - EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its passage, provided the same has been published, with the name of the members voting for and against the same, for at least one publication in one issue of a newspaper published in and having general circulation in Tooele County.


