

ORDINANCE 2003-22

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING TOOELE COUNTY CODE 1-3-7, AND ENACTING SECTION 1-6-3; RE-ESTABLISHING FEES FOR SERVICES PROVIDED BY COUNTY OFFICES

THE COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY OF THE COUNTY OF TOOELE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I - PURPOSE. This ordinance is for the purpose of complying with Utah Code Annotated 17-53-211 which requires the county legislative body to adopt an ordinance establishing fees for services provided by each county officer except fees for the recorder, sheriff and constables, and fees established by statute.

SECTION II - SECTION REPEALED. Title 1, Chapter 3, Section 7, of the Tooele County Code is hereby repealed.

SECTION III - SECTION ENACTED. Title 1, Chapter 6, Section 3 of the Tooele County Code is hereby enacted to read:

1-6-3. Officials' fees.

Pursuant to Utah Code Annotated 17-53-211, the following fees are hereby established for services provided by the corresponding county officer or department:

(9) Fees for the county recorder, sheriff and county constable as established by state statute or by resolution, are set forth in such documents.

SECTION III - REPEALER. Ordinances and resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION IV - EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective 15 days after its passage provided it has been published, or at such publication date if more than 15 days after passage.


