

ORDINANCE 2005-10

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE UNIFORM ZONING ORDINANCE OF TOOELE COUNTY, SECTION 4-14, REGARDING HEIGHT LIMITATIONS ON ACCESSORY BUILDINGS

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF TOOELE COUNTY, UTAH AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I - AMENDMENT. The Uniform Zoning Ordinance of Tooele County, Section 4-14, is hereby amended to read:

4-14 Maximum height of accessory buildings.

No accessory building in a residential (R-1) or residential multi-family (RM) zoning district shall contain more than one story or exceed 20 feet in height. In all other zoning districts, accessory buildings and structures shall not exceed the height of the zoning district in which they are located. No space within an accessory building or structure shall be used as a dwelling.


SECTION II - REPEALER. Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION III - EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective 15 days after its passage provided it has been published, or at such publication date, if more than 15 days after passage.


