

ORDINANCE 2005-25

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TOOELE COUNTY CODE TITLE 10, CHAPTER 1, SECTION 4, ENACTING SUBSECTION 15, GRANTING A FRANCHISE ALONG AND OVER THE PUBLIC ROADS TO STANSBURY PARK IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT

THE COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY OF THE COUNTY OF TOOELE ORDAINS

AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I - PURPOSE. This ordinance is for the purpose of granting a franchise along and over the public roads and highways for all lawful purposes to Stansbury Park Improvement District, a special district of the State of Utah, whose responsibility it is to provide water, sewer, and storm and flood water services to the residents of Stansbury Park.

SECTION II - ENACTMENT. There is hereby granted to Stansbury Park Improvement District, a special district of the State of Utah, its successors and assigns, the non-exclusive right, privilege, or franchise to construct, maintain, and operate systems for the supply, treatment, and distribution of water; systems for the collection, treatment, and disposition of sewage; and systems for the collection, retention, and disposition of storm and flood waters and related facilities along, upon, and across the present and future Tooele County roads, highways, and public places in and around Stansbury Park. The commission chairman is authorized to sign the franchise agreement.

SECTION III - AMENDMENT. Title 10, Chapter 1, Section 4 of the Tooele County Code is amended by enacting Subparagraph 15 as follows:


(15) Stansbury Park Improvement District. A franchise to Stansbury Park Improvement District, a special district of the State of Utah, its successors and assigns, was granted for the purpose of constructing, maintaining, and operating systems for the supply, treatment, and distribution of water; systems for the collection, treatment, and disposition of sewage; and systems for the collection, retention, and disposition of storm and flood waters and related facilities along, upon, and across the present and future Tooele County roads, highways, and public places in Tooele County in and around Stansbury Park. This franchise was granted by Ordinance 2005-25 and continues until October 2055.

SECTION IV - EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective 15 days after its passage provided it has been published, or at such publication date if more than 15 days after passage.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Tooele County Commission, which is the legislative body of Tooele County, passed, approved, and enacted this ordinance this 11th day of October 2005.


