

ORDINANCE 2006-02

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A BOARD OF APPEALS PURSUANT TO SECTION 112 OF THE INTERNATIONAL BUILDING CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOOELE COUNTY COMMISSION AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I - PURPOSE. This ordinance is for the purpose of establishing a Board of Appeals pursuant to Section 112 of the International Building Code.

SECTION II - CHAPTER ENACTED. Title 4, Chapter 16 of the Tooele County Code is hereby enacted to read:

CHAPTER 16

BOARD OF APPEALS

4-16-1. Appeals board established.

There is hereby created the Board of Appeals pursuant to Section 112 of the International Building Code.

4-16-2. Membership.

The Board of Appeals shall be appointed by the Tooele County Commission.

4-16-3. Term in office - Compensation - Removal.

Each member appointed to the Board of Appeals shall serve a four-year term of office. They shall serve without compensation and benefits. They may receive per diem and expenses incurred in the performance of their official duties. Members may be removed by the county commission for cause. Any vacancy which occurs on the board shall be filled by appointment for the unexpired term of the vacated member.

4-16-4. Duties.

The Board of Appeals shall hear and decide appeals of orders, decisions, or determinations made by the building official relative to the application and interpretation of the International Building Code. The board shall have no authority to waive requirements of the International Building Code.


SECTION IV - REPEALER. Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.


