

ORDINANCE 2006-24

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2, SUBSECTION 130 AND CHAPTER 15, TABLE 15-5-3.1(i) OF THE TOOELE COUNTY LAND USE ORDINANCE, TO REDEFINE THE TERM "KENNEL" AND TO ADJUST THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF DOGS ALLOWED AS HOUSEHOLD PETS

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF TOOELE COUNTY, UTAH AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I - PURPOSE. This ordinance seeks to increase the maximum number of household pets allowed in areas zoned Rural Residential, Agriculture, or Multiple Use. The Erda, Pine Canyon, and Tooele County Planning Commissions recommend passage of this ordinance.

SECTION II - DEFINITION AMENDED. Chapter 2, Subsection 130 of the Tooele County Land Use Ordinance is hereby amended to read as follows:

(130) "Kennel" means any premises where domestic animals, such as dogs and cats, older than four months are kept, except where accessory to an agricultural use.

SECTION III - TABLE AMENDED. Chapter 15, Table 15-5-3.1(i) of the Tooele County Land Use Ordinance is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION V - EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective 15 days after its passage provided it has been published, or at such publication date if more than 15 days after passage.
