**AN ORDINANCE VACATING THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY INTEREST
IN PORTIONS OF COUNTRY CLUB DRIVE IN STANSBURY PARK DUE
TO A REALIGNMENT OF THE ROADWAY**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF
TOOELE COUNTY, UTAH AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION I - PURPOSE. Due to a roadway realignment, Tooele County must vacate a portion of the public right-of-way interest in Country Club Drive in Stansbury Park. The Tooele County Planning Commission held a public hearing on the issue and recommends passage of this ordinance.

SECTION II - VACATION. Having provided proper notice pursuant to Utah Code Annotated 72-3-108, a public hearing was conducted and finding good cause therefore, Tooele County hereby vacates a portion of the public right-of-way interest in Country Club Drive in Stansbury Park.

Inasmuch as the vacated area is not part of a subdivision, the County's interest in the vacated portion of Country Club Drive shall be transferred and conveyed to the abutting landowner(s) as designated on the plat map attached hereto as Exhibit A.

A map showing the areas being vacated (Exhibit A) is attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

The Tooele County Clerk is hereby directed to cause this ordinance to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder..

SECTION III - REPEALER. Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.



This ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its passage, provided the same has been published, with the name of the members voting for and against the same, for at least one publication in one issue of a newspaper published in and having general circulation in Tooele County.


