**AN ORDINANCE VACATING THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY INTEREST  
IN ROADS LOCATED SOUTH OF GRANTSVILLE AND WEST OF  
MORMON TRAIL ROAD BETWEEN HICKMAN CANYON AND SOUTH  
WILLOW CANYON**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF  
TOOELE COUNTY, UTAH AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION I - PURPOSE.** Ed Roberts, the owner of property within the proposed road vacations, has submitted an application requesting the vacation of roads located south of Grantsville and west of Mormon Trail Road between Hickman Canyon and South Willow Canyon. The roads are farm roads used by farmers and ranchers for agricultural purposes in transporting livestock. They are not used by the public or lead to any public land. Vacation of these roads will eliminate perceived public access, littering, dumping, and general interference with current agricultural and ranching operations. The Tooele County Planning Commission held a public hearing on the issue and, with a six to one vote, recommends passage of this ordinance.

**SECTION II - ROAD VACATED.** Having provided proper notice pursuant to Utah Code Annotated 72-3-108, a public hearing was conducted and finding good cause therefore, Tooele County hereby vacates the public right-of-way interest in TC03337, TC03338, TC03339, TC03398, TC03399, TC03340, TC03342, TC03400, TC03403, TC03406, TC03724, Richman Way, Prospector Lane, Prospector Road, and Half Section Road.

A map showing the area of the roads being vacated (Exhibit A) is attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

The Tooele County Clerk is hereby directed to cause this ordinance to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder.


**SECTION III - REPEALER.** Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.





