

ORDINANCE 2010-11

AN ORDINANCE ENACTING SECTION 6-18-8 OF THE TOOELE COUNTY CODE, TEMPORARILY CLOSING ALL PUBLIC ROADS AND RIGHT-OF-WAYS ON THE "BIG POLE FIRE" PROPERTY TO ALL MOTORIZED VEHICLES

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF TOOELE COUNTY, UTAH AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I - PURPOSE. Tooele County desires to temporarily close all public roads and right-of-ways on the property affected by the "Big Pole Fire" that occurred in Tooele County in 2009. The County, in conjunction with the BLM, is limiting traffic in this area in order to promote the rehabilitation of the fire-damaged property.

SECTION II - SECTION ENACTED. Section 6-18-8, Use of Motorized Vehicles on "Big Pole Fire" Property Prohibited, of Title 6, Public Safety, of the Tooele County Code is hereby enacted to read as follows:

6-18-8. Use of motorized vehicles on "Big Pole Fire" property prohibited.

(1) No motorized vehicles shall be permitted on the property that is described as follows: All lands, either public or private, that are located south of Interstate 80 (I-80), east of State Route 196 (SR-196), west of the crest of the Stansbury Mountain range, and north of the Skull Valley Goshute Indian Reservation in Tooele County, Utah; includes public lands within Townships 1 through 4 South, Ranges 7 and 8 West, Salt Lake Meridian.

(2) Federal, state, and local government agencies tasked with land management, wildlife management, law enforcement, emergency response, search & rescue, and fire protection are exempt from this restriction while operating within the scope of their official duties. Motor vehicle access by other parties may be allowed, but must be approved in advance in writing by the Tooele County Commission.

- (3) (a) A violation of this section shall be an infraction.
(b) Each violation shall be punishable by:
(i) a fine of not less than \$250 and not more than \$750; and
(ii) 10 hours of community service.

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A map showing the property described above is attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

SECTION III - REPEALER. Ordinances and resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION IV - EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective immediately.

SECTION V - REVIEW OF ORDINANCE. This ordinance shall be reviewed in two years to determine if it is still necessary and expedient to achieve its purpose. The ordinance shall be reviewed every year thereafter until it is repealed.








