

ORDINANCE 2014-01

AN ORDINANCE CONSOLIDATING THE OFFICES OF CLERK AND AUDITOR, FORMING THE OFFICE OF CLERK/AUDITOR, AND CONSOLIDATING THE OFFICES OF RECORDER AND SURVEYOR, FORMING THE OFFICE OF RECORDER/SURVEYOR

WHEREAS, as part of the ongoing effort to streamline County government and in an effort to provide services to citizens in a more efficient and cost-effective manner, Tooele County desires to consolidate certain elected offices as outlined herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF TOOELE COUNTY, UTAH AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I – CONSOLIDATION OF OFFICES – CLERK/AUDITOR. Pursuant to §17-16-3 U.C.A., the Tooele County Commission hereby consolidates the offices of Clerk and Auditor, along with all the respective duties of each office as outlined in Utah Code, to form the office of Clerk/Auditor.

The consolidated office of Clerk/Auditor will be elected during the 2014 election cycle and take office on Monday, January 5, 2015.

After the consolidation, all Tooele County Code references to Clerk or Auditor shall be deemed the same as Clerk/Auditor.

SECTION II – CONSOLIDATION OF OFFICES – RECORDER/SURVEYOR. Pursuant to §17-16-3 U.C.A., the Tooele County Commission hereby consolidates the offices of Recorder and Surveyor, along with all the respective duties of each office as outlined in Utah Code, to form the office of Recorder/Surveyor.

The consolidated office of Recorder/Surveyor will be elected during the 2014 election cycle and take office on Monday, January 5, 2015. In accordance with §17-16-6 U.C.A., the Recorder/Surveyor shall be elected to a one time, six-year term and thereafter four-year terms.

After the consolidation, all Tooele County Code references to Recorder or Surveyor shall be deemed the same as Recorder/Surveyor.


SECTION III - REPEALER. Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION IV - EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its passage, provided the same has been published, with the name of the members voting for and against the same, for at least one publication in one issue of a newspaper published in and having general circulation in Tooele County.


