

MUTUAL ASSISTANCE AND SUPPORT AGREEMENT AMSCM-OPDC-RS-E04  
BETWEEN  
DESERET CHEMICAL DEPOT AND THE TOOELE COUNTY SHERIFF

SUBJECT: Mutual Assistance and Support Agreement between Deseret Chemical Depot and the Tooele County Sheriff

1. PURPOSE. This agreement outlines the areas of responsibility for personnel of Deseret Chemical Depot (DCD) and the Tooele County Sheriff's Office, should an accident or incident occur. This might involve suspected terrorism, acts of civil disturbance, threats, or espionage conducted at DCD, or the release of chemical agents which could have an adverse effect on areas outside the boundaries of DCD. Should such an accident or incident occur, both parties to this agreement will perform the tasks cited in this agreement. Both parties will coordinate emergency efforts with the other party to ensure maximum efficiency of all actions intended to minimize the effects of the accident/incident and safeguard the lives of the public.

2. RESPONSIBILITIES.

a. The Commander, DCD, will ensure the following action is taken, and the Emergency Operations Center (EOC) is notified for the following types of accident/incident:

(1) Notification of the Tooele County Sheriff, as the primary point of contact, with information on the location and type of accident/incident and/or the imminent or actual threat and probable area to be affected.

(2) Request assistance as required according to the type of accident/incident involved. Assistance may be as follows:

(a) Civil Disturbance: When due to the location and type of demonstration the ability of the Depot to accomplish its mission is impacted, DCD may request assistance from Tooele County. DCD will request assistance, to control, disperse, or apprehend persons involved in demonstrations that are located outside the boundaries of Deseret Chemical Depot. Assistance may further be requested to control, disperse, or apprehend persons involved in demonstrations or disturbances that are located within the installation in areas of concurrent jurisdiction.

(b) Security Incidents or Chemical Accidents or Incidents (CA/I): DCD may request assistance for Security incidents (i.e. recapture and recovery operations) or CA/I which result in the actual or potential contamination of areas that are outside the installation boundaries and may affect the local civilian populace. DCD will coordinate with the Tooele County Sheriff, or his designated representative, and provide assistance, as necessary, in identifying and posting of road blocks/traffic control points. Road Blocks/Traffic Control Points selected will restrict the flow of traffic (vehicle and railroad) into the affected areas. Only those emergency personnel required to assist in controlling and neutralizing the accident/incident will be allowed. The proximity map

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identifying the location of pre-determined road blocks/traffic control points is attached at enclosure 1 to this agreement.

(c) Recapture and Recovery Operations: DCD will request assistance in the event that any of the following incidents occur.

- Chemical Agents have been lost, stolen or seized by unauthorized persons and removed from the installation. The potential is present that chemical agents may be removed from the installation, or contamination of an off post areas is present.
- In the event that Chemical Agents have been lost, stolen or seized and removed from the installation and a location has been determined, the DCD Commander or Service Response Force Commander may designate a specified area as a National Defense Area (NDA). This designation is to protect military interests, protect persons, to recover Chemical agents removed from Army custody, and to restore the areas of contamination.
- Assistance will be requested to control and restrict access to the incident site to those emergency personnel required to assist in controlling and neutralizing the incident. If a location is not known, assistance will be requested to search and locate the chemical agent and the person(s) responsible. The Federal Bureau of Investigations (FBI) will be the lead federal agency responsible for search and recovery of chemical agents off the installation. The DCD Recapture and Recovery Plan is provided to the Tooele County Sheriff with this agreement for review and concurrence. Unless otherwise specified, the Tooele County Sheriff will support Recapture and Recovery Operations in accordance with the Recapture and Recovery Plan.

(3) The DCD Commander will take all actions required within the boundaries of DCD to include notification, evacuation, containment and neutralization of chemical hazard sources, medical aid, security and safety.

(4) Notification of all U.S. Government agencies and activities, as required.

(5) Coordinate and conduct training exercises to test the proficiency of all personnel concerned, as required by either agency.

(6) The designated primary assembly points for response forces is building 5108, Emergency Operations Center, Deseret Chemical Depot.

b. The Tooele County Sheriff will ensure the appropriate action is taken for the following accident/incident:

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(1) Upon notification that a security incident or a chemical agent accident has occurred which may endanger areas outside DCD, notify the following personnel or agencies:

- (a) Utah Highway Patrol
- (b) City Police for the areas affected.
- (c) Tooele County Emergency Management.
- (d) Chairman, Tooele County Commissioners.
- (e) Mayor, City or Community affected.

(2) In coordination with the DCD Emergency Operations Center (EOC), establish road blocks/traffic control points to restrict the flow of traffic (vehicle and railroad) into affected areas. Only those personnel properly equipped and required to assist in controlling or neutralizing the accident will be allowed to enter hazardous areas.

(3) In coordination with the DCD EOC, provide sufficient personnel to assist in controlling access to designated National Defense Areas.

(4) In coordination with DCD and the FBI, assist as necessary with available resources in the search, containment, recapture and recovery of chemical agents wrongfully removed from U.S. Army Custody.

(5) Coordinate emergency actions with the DCD Law Enforcement and Security representative at the DCD EOC for mutual assistance and information.

(6) Upon notification by the Commander of imminent or actual threat which may endanger personnel or property outside the boundaries of DCD, furnish the necessary support. This could include up to 100 local and state Law Enforcement to cordon off and/or block entrance and exit points to the installation and to surrounding areas.

(7) Provide the necessary Law Enforcement support in the apprehension or arrest of personnel involved in an unlawful act against the U.S. Government.

(8) In coordination with DCD, participate in tests and rehearsals, as required by either agency.

(9) Provide to the DCD Security Officer or Security Manager any information specifying a threat or implied threat to Deseret Chemical Depot, any major tenant activities on the Depot or any personnel employed at the Depot.

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c. Tooele County personnel, acting pursuant to this agreement, shall be considered to be acting according to lawful orders of the Tooele County Sheriff, or the Chairman of the Tooele County Commissioners, and therefore, acting within the scope of their employment and not as employees of the Deseret Chemical Depot.

d. It is expressly mutually agreed between parties hereto, that any claim against either party for compensation for service, supplies, or equipment utilized in consequence of the performance of this agreement is hereby waived.

e. The undersigned agree to mutually support each other as outlined in this agreement.

f. This agreement may be terminated by either party by sending written notice thereof to the other party at least sixty (60) days in advance of the desired cancellation or termination date.

3. The execution of this agreement by the U.S. Government is authorized by paragraph 3-8a, AR 190-59, Chemical Agent Security Program, 11 Sep 06.








**CSEPP RESPONSE MAP**
