MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

TOOELE COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE

SUBJECT: Escort of Hazardous Material on Tooele County Roads.

1. Reference.

- a. Army Regulation 50-6, Chemical Surety, 28 July 2008.
- b. DoD Instruction 4000.19, Interservice and Intragovernmental Support, 9 August 1995.
- c. Department of the Army Message, Subject: Department of the Army Civilian Police and Security Guards, 7 August 2000.
- d. ATEC Regulation 1-35, Agreements/Understandings and Intraservice/Interservice Support Agreements, 4 October 2005.
- e. Tooele County Ordinance 2001-39, Ordinance for Establishing Fees for Municipal Services.

2. Purpose. This Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) constitutes an agreement between U.S. Army Dugway Proving Ground (DPG) and Tooele County Sheriff's Office (TCSO) concerning escort support for transporting chemical and biological, and other hazardous materials on Tooele County Roads.

3. Problem. Should an incident occur during the movement of hazardous materials, DA Civilian Police and Security Guards do not have the authority or the jurisdiction to enforce laws off the military installation.

4. Scope. This agreement applies to Tooele County Sheriff's Office and Dugway Proving Ground, and limited to the movement of hazardous materials through Tooele County.

5. Understandings, agreements, support and resources.

- a. TCSO's support to DPG shall be provided on an as needed basis. DPG will ensure that requests for TCSO support are communicated through the Chief Deputy at the TCSO, seven days, if possible, in advance of required support.

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b. DPG will reimburse Tooele County for costs of support at a rate of Forty Dollars (US\$40.00) per hour expended, plus actual costs of materials, supplies, and equipment used in providing such services. Tooele County will provide an invoice to U.S. Army Dugway Proving Ground, Resource Management Division, TEDT-DP-RM-B, Kuddes Building, MS #04, Dugway, UT 84022-0004.


6. Effective date. This agreement shall take effect upon the last signature and shall continue until amended or terminated in writing with thirty-day notice. This agreement supersedes Memorandum of Agreement dated 24 May 2006. Review of this agreement will be initiated by DPG' Support Agreement Manger, triennially, on the anniversary date.
