

ORDINANCE 2000-4

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TOOELE COUNTY CODE
TITLE 10, CHAPTER 1, SECTION 4, ENACTING
SUBSECTION 11, GRANTING AN ELECTRIC FRANCHISE
TO GREAT SALT LAKE ENERGY**

**THE COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY OF THE COUNTY OF TOOELE ORDAINS AS
FOLLOWS:**

SECTION I - PURPOSE. This ordinance is for the purpose of granting an electric franchise to Great Salt Lake Energy to provide electric service to MagCorp.

SECTION II - ENACTMENT. There is hereby granted to Great Salt Lake Energy, its successors and assigns, the non-exclusive right, privilege, or franchise to construct, maintain and operate in, along, upon and across the present and future roads, highways and public places in Tooele County, Utah. The commission chairman is authorized to sign the Franchise Agreement so certifying.

SECTION III - AMENDMENT. Title 10, Chapter 1, Section 4 of the Tooele County Code is amended by adopting Subparagraph 11 as follows:


(11) A franchise to Great Salt Lake Energy, its successors and assigns, was granted for the purpose of constructing, maintaining and operating an electric generation, transmission and distribution company and to construct, maintain and operate poles, lines and facilities along, upon and across the present and future roads, highways and public places in Tooele County. This franchise is granted by Ordinance 2000-4 and continues until February 15, 2050.

SECTION IV - EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective 15 days after its passage provided it has been published, or at such publication date if more than 15 days after passage.

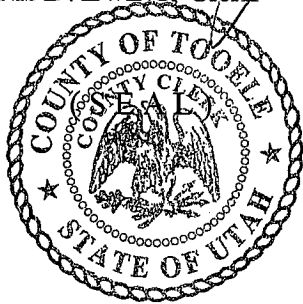
IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Tooele County Legislative Body passed, approved and enacted this ordinance this 15th day of February 2000.
