

ORDINANCE 2004-23

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE ACCIDENT REVIEW BOARD

WHEREAS, Tooele County is required by insurance best practices to establish an accident review board;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF TOOELE COUNTY, UTAH AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I - CHAPTER ENACTED. Tooele County Code Chapter 4-20 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

CHAPTER 20

ACCIDENT REVIEW BOARD

- 4-20-1. Board established.**
- 4-20-2. Membership and terms.**
- 4-20-3. Duties.**

4-20-1. Board established.

There is hereby created the Tooele County Accident Review Board.

4-20-2. Membership and terms.

Accident Review Board members shall be appointed by the Tooele County Commission. Their terms will run indefinitely.

4-20-3. Duties.


The Accident Review Board shall review and monitor all accidents, damage, loss, and claims regarding Tooele County property and also those accidents caused by or involving on-duty county employees. The board shall make recommendations to the county commission for safety initiatives for the protection of county employees and equipment and for the protection of the general public.


SECTION II - EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective 15 days after its passage provided it has been published, or at such publication date, if more than 15 days after passage.


