

ORDINANCE 2009-27

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 15, TABLE 15-5-3.2, AND CHAPTER 16, TABLE 16-4-3.2, OF THE TOOELE COUNTY LAND USE ORDINANCE, REVISING THE CRITERIA FOR RESIDENTIAL CHILD CARE AND PRESCHOOL FACILITIES

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF TOOELE COUNTY, UTAH AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I - PURPOSE. This ordinance seeks to update the criteria for residential child care and preschool facilities within Tooele County. The amendments will ensure consistency with the State of Utah's regulations and allow the State to assist with regulation in the County. The Erda, Pine Canyon, and Tooele County Planning Commissions held public hearings on the issue and recommend passage of this ordinance.

SECTION II - TABLES AMENDED. Chapter 15, Table 15-5-3.2, and Chapter 16, Table 16-4-3.2, of the Tooele County Land Use Ordinance are hereby amended to read as attached hereto, which attachment is, by this reference, made a part hereof.

SECTION III - REPEALER. Ordinances and resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION IV - EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective 15 days after its passage provided it has been published, or at such publication date if more than 15 days after passage.

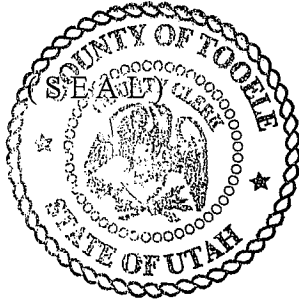




Clearances of employees shall be made through the tooele county sheriff's office prior to any contact with any children; and~~
- 14. The number of children allowed at the pre-school at any one time shall be determined by the zoning administrator No more than sixteen (16) children, with up to eight (8) children per one (1) adult working at the preschool, shall be permitted.
