AN ORDINANCE RENAMING A PORTION OF ABERDEEN LANE IN STANSBURY PARK TO STALLION WAY, IN HONOR OF STANSBURY HIGH SCHOOL (THE PORTION OF ABERDEEN LANE BETWEEN BATES CANYON ROAD AND VILLAGE BOULEVARD)

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF TOOELE COUNTY, UTAH AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I – PURPOSE. The Student Body Officers of Stansbury High School, in an effort to promote community and school pride, have requested that the portion of Aberdeen Lane between Bates Canyon Road and Village Boulevard be renamed to Stallion Way.

SECTION II – CHANGE. Tooele County, having proper authority under Utah Code Annotated § 17-34-1 and with approval from the Tooele County Recorder as acting supervisor for the Building and Development Services Division (formerly known as the Engineering Department) and in accordance with Tooele County Code Section 13-7-3, does hereby change the name of the portion of Aberdeen Lane between Bates Canyon Road and Village Boulevard to Stallion Way.

The Tooele County Clerk is hereby directed to cause this ordinance to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder.

SECTION III – REPEALER. Ordinances and resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION IV - EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective fifteen (15) days after its passage, provided it has been published, or at such publication date if more than fifteen (15) days after passage.

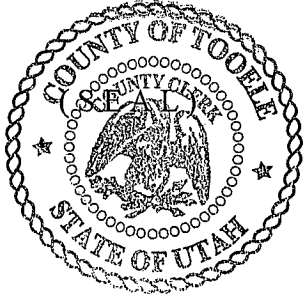
