

RESOLUTION 2002-22

A RESOLUTION AMENDING TOOELE COUNTY PERSONNEL POLICIES AND PROCEDURES SECTIONS 6.G., ELIMINATING AUTHORIZATION OF HOLIDAY PAY FOR TEMPORARY AND SEASONAL EMPLOYEES

WHEREAS, the Tooele County Commission desires to amend the county's personnel policies and procedures to eliminate the option for authorization of holiday pay for seasonal employees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF TOOELE COUNTY AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I - SECTION AMENDED: Section 6.G of the Tooele County Personnel Policies and Procedures is hereby amended to read:


TEMPORARY AND SEASONAL EMPLOYEES: Temporary and seasonal employees work on a short-term basis, usually to perform a specific piece of work. Applicants must meet the position's minimum qualifications. Such employment shall not exceed one year. The hiring authority shall notify the director of personnel management before any offer is made. The hiring of seasonal employees who may be required to work more than six months in a year and who may be recalled from year to year as departmental needs dictate shall follow the regular hiring procedure. Temporary and seasonal employees receive no fringe benefits.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This resolution shall take effect on December 29, 2002.


