

RESOLUTION 2003-09

A RESOLUTION AMENDING TOOELE COUNTY PERSONNEL POLICIES AND PROCEDURES SECTION 16.H.10, SAFETY RULES AND REGULATIONS

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the county's personnel policies and procedures Section 16.H.10 to correct now obsolete references to the Utah Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF TOOELE COUNTY THAT Section 16.H.10 of the Tooele County Personnel Policies and Procedures is hereby amended to read:


10. Employees shall wear seat belts while driving or riding in any motor vehicle being used for county business including private vehicles. This subsection does not apply to a passenger if all seating positions are occupied by other passengers. This subsection also does not apply to a driver or passenger of:
 - a. a motor vehicle manufactured before July 1, 1966;
 - b. a motor vehicle in which the driver or passengers possess a written verification from a licensed physician that the driver or passenger is unable to wear a safety belt for physical or medical reasons; or
 - c. a motor vehicle or seating position which is not required to be equipped with a safety belt system under federal law.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
