

RESOLUTION NO. 03- 11

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, OF TOOELE COUNTY, STATE OF UTAH FOR THE PURPOSE OF CREATING AND MAINTAINING A LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT, PURSUANT TO TITLE 26A, CHAPTER 1.

WHEREAS, the State Legislature has mandated Tooele County to create and maintain a local health department, which includes and serves all incorporated and unincorporated areas of the County (26A-1-103).

General Provisions

Local Boards of Health - Membership - Organization - Meetings. The local Board of Health shall consist of nine members. The purpose of the Board of Health is to evaluate and recommend policies and procedures of the operation for the Tooele County Health Department to promote the general health of all citizens. Board members shall be appointed according to the bylaws of the Tooele County Health Department. The Board shall be composed of influential citizens with experience, abilities and points of views that will contribute to the effective management of Tooele County Health Department. All members of the Board shall reside within Tooele County. Board members shall serve for three years. No member shall serve more than four consecutive terms. Board members may be removed by the appointing county for cause prior to expiration of a member's term. Any Board member removed pursuant to State law may request and receive a hearing before the county legislative body prior to the effective date of the removal (26A-1-9).

Local Health Officer - Powers and Duties - Vacancy. The Board of Health shall appoint a local health officer and determine the officer's compensation subject to ratification by the County Commission (26A-1-110).

Removal of Local Health Officer. The local health officer may be removed for cause in accordance with 26A-1-111.

Appointment of Personnel. All local health department personnel shall be hired by the local health officer or his designee in accordance with the merit system, personnel policies and compensation plans approved by the Board and ratified by the County Commission (26A-1-112).

Funding of Departments - Tax Levies. Counties involved in the establishment and operation

of a local health department shall fund the local health department with appropriations from the General Fund or in part by tax levy under Section 17-53-221, which establishes a separate ceiling exempt tax which may not exceed .0004 per dollar of taxable value of taxable property (26A-1-117)


Local Health Department Fund - Sources - Uses. Moneys credited to the health department shall be placed in a restricted account and expended only for maintenance and operation of the local health department (26A-1-119).


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOOELE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF TOOELE COUNTY that the Tooele County Health Department is created and has jurisdiction in all unincorporated and incorporated areas of the County and shall enforce State laws, Department of Health, Department of Environmental Quality and local health department rules, regulations and standards within Tooele County (26A-1-108).
