

RESOLUTION NO. 2003-18

A RESOLUTION TENTATIVELY ADOPTING THE TENTATIVE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2004, AND ESTABLISHING THE TIME AND PLACE OF A PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER ADOPTION OF THE FINAL BUDGET

WHEREAS, Section 17-36-10, Utah Code Annotated, 1953, as amended requires that on or before the first day of the next to last month of every fiscal year, the budget officer shall prepare for the next budget year and file with the governing body a tentative budget for each fund for which a budget is required; and

WHEREAS, the auditor, in his function as budget officer, has prepared and submitted to the county commission a tentative budget for each fund for the ensuing year; and

WHEREAS, the commission has reviewed and considered the tentative budget and desires to tentatively adopt the same and establish a time and place of a public hearing to consider adoption of a final budget;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the tentative budget for each fund for the ensuing year, 2004, as attached hereto, is hereby tentatively adopted.


IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that a public hearing to consider the adoption of the Tooele County budget for 2004 shall be held on the 16th day of December 2003, at 3:00 p.m., at the Tooele County Courthouse, 47 South Main Street, Tooele, Utah. The county clerk shall cause notice of a public hearing to consider adoption of the final budget to be published at least seven days

prior to the hearing in at least one issue of the Tooele Transcript Bulletin, a newspaper of general circulation published in Tooele County.


