

RESOLUTION H2003-3

**A RESOLUTION DISSOLVING THE TOOELE COUNTY
HOSPITAL SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, the Board of the Tooele County Hospital Special Service District does hereby find and determine that all bonds, notes, and other obligations of the District have been paid, that there is no contractual obligation to provide further service, and that it is in the public interest and welfare of the residents of the District to dissolve the District;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF THE TOOELE COUNTY HOSPITAL SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICT that pursuant to Utah Code Ann. §17A-2-1329 the Tooele County Hospital Special Service District which was created by Ordinance 87-20 and is described below is hereby dissolved:


Beginning at the middle point of a straight line drawn between a point on the west shore of Great Salt Lake at latitude 41 degrees north and a point on the east shore of said lake due west of the middle of the channel of the Weber River and north of the northwest corner of Kingston's Fort; thence southwesterly along said line to the west shore of said lake; thence west to the western boundary of the State; thence south to the second standard parallel south; thence east to the summit of the divide between Cherry and Faust Creeks; thence along the summit of the range next east of the Rush and Tooele Valleys to the northern end of said summit; thence northeasterly on a straight line through Black Rock on the shore of Great Salt Lake to the point of beginning; excluding therefrom all territory encompassed within the boundaries of the City of Wendover, Utah, such city being located wholly within Tooele County, Utah, as such boundaries exist as of October 6, 1987.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This resolution shall take effect ~~immediately upon passage.~~ *Dec. 31, 2003*


