

RESOLUTION 2005-02

**ESTABLISHING FEES FOR ALL FUTURE
WASTE DISPOSAL CONTRACTS FOR POWER PLANT DEBRIS**

WHEREAS, Tooele County has previously entered into a contract dated July 9, 1987, with Envirocare of Utah, Inc., for the purpose of receiving fees as a condition to permit the storage of low-level radioactive waste in Tooele County; and


WHEREAS, in order to maximize Tooele County's revenue from this contract, certain limited waste streams, including power plant debris, have been allowed to be disposed at less than five percent (5%) of the gross revenues, pursuant to the March 14, 1995, amendment to the contract; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOOELE COUNTY COMMISSION that all future waste disposal contracts for power plant debris shall incur a fee to Tooele County of five percent (5%) on gross revenues, unless first expressly agreed otherwise by Tooele County in writing pursuant to the provisions of the July 9, 1987, contract, as amended, between Tooele County and Envirocare of Utah, Inc.


