

RESOLUTION 2006-23

ENACTING SECTION 32, EMERGENCY RESPONSE PROGRAM FOR REPORTS OF DAMAGED OR MISSING SIGNS, OF THE PERSONNEL POLICIES AND PROCEDURES MANUAL

WHEREAS, the county commission finds it necessary to enact an emergency response program for reports of damaged or missing signs to comply with insurance recommendations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOOEELE COUNTY COMMISSION that Personnel Policies and Procedures Section 32, Emergency Response Program for Reports of Damaged or Missing Signs, is hereby enacted to read as follows:

EMERGENCY RESPONSE PROGRAM FOR REPORTS OF DAMAGED OR MISSING SIGNS

Reports of damaged or missing road signs shall be forwarded to the Tooele County Roads Division of the Engineering Department. Such reports shall be responded to by the Roads Division within 48 hours of receiving the report. Stop signs shall be replaced immediately, and, when necessary, the Roads Division shall request the Sheriff's Office to respond to a report of a missing or damaged stop sign at hazardous intersections until the sign is replaced. All reports of missing or damaged signs shall be kept along with a written report stating the replacement or repair date, the employee who made the repair, and the time the repair was made.

This resolution shall take effect immediately.


