

RESOLUTION 2007-08

A RESOLUTION ELECTING TO ADMINISTER FUTURE ELECTIONS FOR IBAPAH, OPHIR, DUGWAY, RUSH VALLEY, TERRA, VERNON, AND WENDOVER, ENTIRELY BY ABSENTEE BALLOT


WHEREAS, Utah Code Ann. 20A-3-302 allows the county legislative body to elect to administer an election entirely by absentee ballot if on the 60th day before an election there are 500 or fewer persons registered to vote in a voting precinct;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOOELE COUNTY COMMISSION that all future elections in the Ibapah, Ophir, Dugway, Rush Valley, Terra, Vernon, and Wendover voting precincts shall be administered entirely by absentee ballot if the County Clerk finds that there are 500 or fewer persons registered to vote in each voting precinct on the 60th day before an election. Prior to each election, the County Clerk, by way of an agenda item at a regularly scheduled Commission Meeting, shall certify to the County Commission the actual number of persons registered to vote in each of the above-named voting precincts on the 60th day before the election. If the County Clerk certifies that there are fewer than 500 persons registered to vote in said precincts, the County Commission, by way of motion and vote, may elect to administer the upcoming election entirely by absentee ballot in said precincts. The County Clerk shall mail to each registered voter within those voting precincts the absentee ballot, with prepaid return postage, and all other information required by Section 20A-3-302 of the Utah Code, and conduct the election as stated therein. This resolution shall take effect immediately.


