

RESOLUTION 2013-01

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND SETTING A DATE FOR A SPECIAL ELECTION IN THE SOUTH RIM SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICT; THE ELECTION WILL SEEK TO AUTHORIZE A PROPERTY TAX LEVY AND ESTABLISH THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF REVENUE THAT CAN BE GENERATED BY THE LEVY

WHEREAS, a special service district is required to obtain the approval of a majority of the registered voters within a special service district prior to levying a property tax (Utah Code 17D-1-105(2)); and

WHEREAS, the South Rim Special Service District has expressed its desire to have a property tax levy imposed to fund the service district's operations; and

WHEREAS, Tooele County has the authority to authorize a special election for this purpose (Utah Code 11-14-201);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF TOOELE COUNTY that a special election will be held within the South Rim Special Service District on June 25, 2013 for the purpose of authorizing a property tax levy and establishing the maximum amount of revenue that can be generated by the levy.

The language of the ballot proposition shall read as follows:

SOUTH RIM SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICT PROPOSITION #1:

Shall the South Rim Special Service District be authorized to levy property tax at a rate that generates \$12,000.00 or less annually?






