A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE CONCEPT OF RELOCATING THE UTAH STATE PRISION FACILITY (DRAPER) TO TOOEELE COUNTY

WHEREAS, the State of Utah has publicly expressed interest in relocating the Utah State Prison facility located in Draper; and

WHEREAS, Tooele County has been mentioned as a possible relocation site; and

WHEREAS, Tooele County is interested in participating in the process the State will use to identify and ultimately select a relocation site or sites; and

WHEREAS, Tooele County believes that in order for Tooele County to more fully participate in the process that will be used by the State to identify and select a relocation site, it is in the "best interest" of Tooele County to make a public statement in support of the concept of relocating the Draper facility to Tooele County;


