

RESOLUTION 2013-06

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND SETTING A DATE FOR A SPECIAL ELECTION IN THE NORTH TOOELE COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION SERVICE DISTRICT; THE ELECTION WILL SEEK TO RE-ESTABLISH THE MAXIMUM TAX RATE CAP

WHEREAS, pursuant to Utah Code Annotated 17D-1-105(2), a special service district is required to obtain the approval of a majority of the registered voters within a special service district prior to levying a property tax; and

WHEREAS, the North Tooele County Fire Protection Service District has expressed its desire to re-establish a maximum tax rate cap in order to have a property tax levy to fund the District's operations; and

WHEREAS, Tooele County has the authority to authorize a special election for this purpose (Utah Code 11-14-201);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF TOOELE COUNTY that a special election will be held within the North Tooele County Fire Protection Service District on June 25, 2013 for the purpose of re-establishing the maximum tax rate cap.

The language of the ballot proposition shall read as follows:

NORTH TOOELE COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION SERVICE DISTRICT PROPOSITION #1:

Shall the North Tooele County Fire Protection Service District be authorized to set the maximum tax rate cap at 0.000850 annually?







WHEREAS, pursuant to Utah Code annotated 17D-1-105(2), a special service district is required to obtain the approval of a majority of the registered voters within a special service district prior to levying a property tax; and

WHEREAS, the District desires to establish a maximum tax rate cap in order to have a property tax levy to fund the District's operations; and

WHEREAS, Tooele County has the authority to authorize a special election for this purpose (Utah Code 11-14-201);
