



Tooele County is seeking members for our bipartisan Career Service Council

Purpose of the Service Council

The Career Service Council is appointed to hear appeals not resolved at lower levels in the cases of career service employees suspended, transferred, demoted or dismissed and grievances not resolved by the grievance procedure at the division or departmental level. The Career Service Council also serves a role in the recruitment and hiring process for the County Human Resource Director. Pursuant to Utah State Code 17-33-4.

Structure of Service Council

Each council member shall serve a term of up to three years. Council members shall receive compensation for each day or partial day they are in session at a per diem rate determined by the county legislative body.

Career Service Eligibility

- 1.) Council members must disclose their political party affiliation.
- 2.) Must be a Tooele County resident not less than 1 year.
- 3.) Must not hold another government office or be employed by the county.
- 4.) Council members shall be persons with knowledge of merit principles of public employment.
